## **HURRICANE HELENE RELIEF AID**

## Flood clean-up kit

- 1. One five-gallon round bucket with re-sealable lid (14.35" h x 12.19" w x 12.19" d)

  No screw lids, may be used, but must be free from all residual product, and advertisements on the outside acceptable
- 2. A One 32-64 oz. bottle liquid laundry detergent
- 3. A One 16-40 oz. bottle liquid concentrate household cleaner No spray cleaners, please
- 4. A One 16-34 oz. bottle dish soap
- 5. One 4-8 oz. pump spray air freshener (liquid, not gel)
- 6. One 6-14 oz. pump spray insect repellent (pack of 10-20 wipes also acceptable)

  Pump spray bottles must have protective covers
- 7. A One scrub brush (with or without handle)
- 8. 18 re-useable cleaning wipes (no terrycloth, microfiber or paper towels, please remove from packaging)
- 9. Five scouring pads (no stainless-steel pads with soap in them, remove from packaging)
- 10. **A** 36-50 clothespins
- 11. A One 50-100 ft. clothesline (cotton or plastic line)
- 12. 24 roll of heavy-duty trash bags (33-45-gallon sizes) please remove from packaging
- 13. Five N95 particulate respirator dust masks (1-3 mm thickness) no surgical masks
- 14. Two pairs kitchen gloves (durable for multiple uses, remove from packaging)
- 15. One pair work gloves (cotton with leather palm or all leather)

## Hygiene Kit

- 1. One one-gallon size re-sealable bag
- 2. A One hand towel (15 x 25 –17 x 27 inches)
- 3. One washcloth
- 4. One comb (rattail and combs without handles are acceptable but must have at least 4-7 inches of teeth)
- 5. A One toenail or fingernail clipper
- 6. Bath-size soap (3 oz. bar or larger) do not remove it from packaging
- 7. One adult toothbrush do not remove from packaging.
- 8. Unopened toothpaste
- 9. Hand sanitizer
- 10. A Small shampoo
- 11. 10 adhesive bandages (¾ by 3 inches) common household bandages are acceptable
