

As We Gather.... We see in verse 7, Paul uses the metaphor of "jars of clay" to describe human frailty and mortality to his disciples. But he is also talking to us. The "treasure" represents the knowledge of God's glory and the Gospel of Jesus Christ. By placing this "treasure" is "jars of clay", which in reality are fragile and ordinary human beings, Paul emphasizes that the extraordinary power and greatness; the true "treasures" comes from God, not from the humans who carry it. This highlights the contrast

between the power of God and human weakness, underscoring that any success or impact of the Gospel is due to the "treasures" of God's light, in, with, and under the "treasures" of Jesus' life.....not human effort or ability. Despite the challenges and sufferings that we encounter, we are...like the disciples.....to continue to serve faithfully, knowing that God's power through Christ Jesus sustains us.
