

As We Gather.....we see Paul sharing a profound personal experience and a significant lesson on humility and reliance on God's grace. Paul describes his vision where he describes a man (likely himself) who was caught up to the "third heaven" or Paradise, where he heard inexpressible things that he is not permitted to tell. This vision happened fourteen years prior. To keep him from becoming conceited due to these extraordinary revelations, Paul was given a "thorn in the flesh," described as a messenger of Satan to torment him. Despite pleading with the Lord three times to remove it, God's response was, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness". Paul concludes that he will boast all the more gladly about his weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on him. He takes pleasure in weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and difficulties, for when he is weak, then he is strong.


